Henry B. DeLozier is Vice President of Golf for Pulte Homes. He is responsible for the Pulte business strategy concerning the portfolio of golf assets, for its golf and country clubs in planning and for the corporate intellectual property aligned with golf.

Pulte Homes is the largest developer of golf course communities in the United States with more than 30 new courses in planning. The company has previously developed more than 50 courses within its master planned communities across the country. Pulte currently owns or controls 20 golf courses, which have a replacement value in excess of \$300 million and produce annual revenues greater than \$85 million.

He is the current President of the Board of Directors for the National Golf Course Owners Association (NGCOA).
