Joe Munsch is the president and chief executive officer of EAGL. Joe Munsch, a 31-year veteran of the public golf and private club industry, is the President and Chief Operating Officer of EAGL. After graduating from the University of Texas in Austin in 1975, Joe joined ClubCorp and progressed in various roles through the company. During his tenure at ClubCorp Joe held such varied positions as the Controller of ClubCorp, President of CCA Financial Management Corporation, and President of Architectural Designers, Inc., the construction and design division of ClubCorp. In 1986, Joe moved to the operating side of the business as the Executive Vice President of Development where he was responsible for the start up, design, construction, and planning for all new and proposed ClubCorp properties. Joe also served on the Board of Directors for the parent company.

In 1996, Joe joined Golf Enterprises, Inc. (GEI) to oversee the operations of their forty-five (45) golf and private club properties. In 1997, GEI was merged into American Golf Corporation (AGC) and Joe joined the company as the EVP of Private Club Operations. In 1998, Joe was named the Chief Operating Officer of AGC, with responsibility for over seventy (70) private clubs and two hundred and thirty (230) daily fee and resort golf operations in the United States and the United Kingdom.
