Steve Mona, CAE, became GCSAA's CEO in November 1993. Steve has established a strong career record of service to the golf industry. He served as tournament director of the Northern California Golf Association from September 1980 to January 1982. He then became assistant manager of press relations for the United States Golf Association from January 1982 to June 1983. In June 1983, Steve became executive director of the Georgia State Golf Association, a position he held until assuming his duties at GCSAA in 1993. Steve's exploits have been well recognized. In 2001, Crittenden Golf Inc. magazine selected him as one of golf's top 25 "Most Dynamic Movers & Shakers." In 1999, Golf Digest listed Steve as one of the golf industry's "Most Powerful People in Golf." In 1997, the Kansas City Society of Association Executives named him Association Executive of the Year.
